



SHE CARRIES HER HOUSE announces REMAINING NATIVE

YERINGTON, NV / BROOKLYN, NY - 12/16 THURSDAY -- SHE CARRIES HER HOUSE (SCHH) is proud to announce the launch of a sneak peek of REMAINING NATIVE, a documentary feature following the life story of Kutoven "Ku" Stevens, directed by Haudenosaunee filmmaker Paige Bethmann.

Remaining Native is a story about Indigenous resilience, reclamation, and pride as 18-year-old cross country runner, Ku Stevens, runs the 50-mile escape route his great grandfather took as he fled from Indian Boarding School at only 8 years old. Ku's run comes in the wake of the first federal investigation into Indian Boarding Schools.

The film is in the early stages of production and will follow Ku Stevens through his Senior year of high school. The film will also follow the federal investigation into Indian Boarding Schools that was announced by the Department of the Interior Secretary Deb Haaland last June. The film is hoping to raise \$50K through its fundraiser to continue production in 2022 with the anticipated release fall 2023.
